This unique program, specifically designed for front-line officers, blends evidence-driven principles with practical tactics, emphasizing critical decision-making, legal use of force, and de-escalation strategies, all while understanding human reactions under extreme stress.

Participants will gain insights into psychological responses in high-stress scenarios, complemented by topics on the Constitutional Use of Force and coordination tactics with other officers.

The course concludes with practical, reality-based scenarios that reinforce the application of learned skills, particularly understanding stressed human behavior, ensuring readiness for real-world challenges.
